### **Enrichment Policies**

 All dogs <b>must pass a Temperament Evaluation</b> prior to acceptance into the Enrichment Program. The Whitesburg Animal Hospital Enrichment staff will not knowingly admit any obviously aggressive dogs into the Program.
 Enrichment participants must be able to get along well with humans as well as other dogs. If a dog does not pass the temperament evaluation, we will recommend training classes to help the dog become more social and reevaluate after completion of those classes.
 If a previously evaluated dog has not participated in our Enrichment Program within the last six months, it will be necessary for the dog to be reevaluated to determine which playgroup it is best suited for its temperament and activity level.
In order to maintain a safe and fun environment, participants are expected to maintain a degree of "playgroup etiquette". Our staff acts as a "referee" by enforcing certain rules such as no jumping, fighting, and etcetera with a kind but firm demeanor. Dogs can be unpredictable and sometimes act out of character by demonstrating aggression or nonsocial behavior towards staff or other participants. When this happens, the offender may be put in time-out. Time out consists of the dog being put in an area by themselves for approximately 5 minutes to allow them to settle down. If behavior becomes consistent, the dog may be suspended from the program until aggression issues have been addressed and resolved. After counseling and/or additional training, dogs may be reevaluated; however, if the participant again begins to demonstrate unacceptable behavior they may be permanently expelled from the program.
 Playgroups are determined by our trained staff and are based on size, temperament, and activity level of each individual participant.
 In order to protect participants from communicable diseases, all dogs must be part of a health maintenance program that includes the following: Rabies, Distemper Combination, Bordetella and Bivalent Canine Influenza Vaccinations, Annual Wellness Examination, and a Negative Fecal Examination.
 To reduce the risk of internal and external parasite transmission, <b>all participants must be</b> <b>current on heartworm and flea/tick prevention</b> . If any pet is found to have external parasites, Whitesburg Animal Hospital will apply a single dose of prevention at the client's expense.
 All participants must be in good health. All known medical conditions should be notated on the bottom of this form.
 By six months of age, all dogs must be spayed or neutered.
 <b>Participants must wear a flat collar with identification and be leash trained</b> . For the safety of our participants, we ask that all pets arrive and depart on leash.
 Whitesburg Animal Hospital is not responsible for any personal items such as bedding or leashes left while your pet is in our care.

	Enrichment hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.		
	The Enrichment entrance is open Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. and from 4:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m. Participants may be dropped off and picked up through the main hospital entrance between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.		
	All boarders must be checked in and out through the main hospital entrance.		
	<ul> <li>If your pet is scheduled to have any medical services while here for Enrichment, please drop off and pick up at the main hospital entrance.</li> <li>All dogs must be picked up by 6:00 p.m. There will be a \$2.50 per minute late fee for any pet picked up between 6:01 p.m. and 6:10 p.m. All dogs still in our care at 6:10 p.m. will be boarded at the owner's expense.</li> </ul>		
	Enrichment participants may be photographed and/or videotaped without compensation during their playgroup sessions. These photographs and/or videotapes may appear on Whitesburg Animal Hospital's website, Social Media accounts, Enrichment Yearbook and/or marketing campaigns.		
	Whitesburg Animal Hospital strives to keep our facility clean and sanitary and uses all reasonable precautions to prevent injury, illnesses and/or escape. Under no circumstances will Whitesburg Animal Hospital be responsible for the actions of the pet or other pets in the playgroup that may cause injury, illness, or escape.

	Each pet owner accepts full financial responsibility for his or her own pet's veterinary services resulting from any injuries and/or illnesses contracted while their pet participated in our Enrichment Program.		

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- If a pet should become ill, injured or in need of medical attention while in our care, Whitesburg Animal Hospital reserves the right to administer aid and stabilize the patient until the owner and/or emergency contact can be reached. Any expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the owner.
  - Your pet's coat may be wet when you pick them up during the summer. On nice summer days, they may have been lounging in the pools. Not to worry, the water is changed frequently to keep them clean and healthy.
